And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people. And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the vision of the evening and the morning which was told is true; wherefore shut thou up the vision; for it shall be for many days.

Of all the powers, named in these visions, none but Pagan Rome could stand up against the Prince of Princes, as this only prevailed during the life of Christ.

Syria became a Province of Rome 65 yrs. before Christ. see Whelpley's Compend. page 120. Of course Pagan Rome only could stand up against the Prince of Princes. Pagan Rome commences the little horn of Daniel 8:9, terminating with the papacy at the end of 2300 days.
